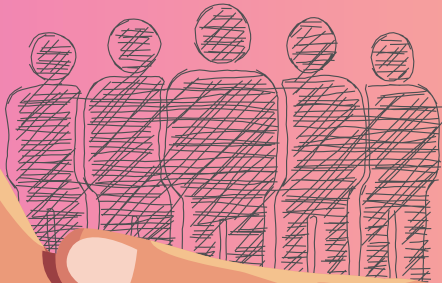

A Letter from the Pastor...

Spring Time, Growing in Christ-likeness



How does a person start the process of growing in Christ-likeness? It begins in sharing and receiving the gospel. In my experience sometimes a single conversation starter is a cry from someone that wants to know more about Christ. Taking the time to listen and engage in relationship is a way of working with the Holy Spirit on what is happening in this person's life. When an individual becomes somewhat comfortable in a relationship, questions will arise. My first commitment is to listen, ask questions to make sure I am not misinterpreting, and genuinely care for this individual. If and when I am asked questions about my life, the best answer is to share my own story. Since God's grace is working in this individual there is no need for me to persuade, convince, or convert. That is the job of the Holy Spirit. My job is to share my story with that individual. At that point, it may be that this individual will desire to come to Christ. Through prayer I can then lead this person to acknowledge repentance of sins and a desire to come to Christ.

This is only the beginning. God desires so much more for all of us. My job is to continue to deepen my relationship with this person. People are looking for community and God reveals His plan through community. It is in community where this individual's faith will grow. It is in community that this individual will become a disciple of Christ. Jesus called the twelve - He lived, walked, and taught these twelve so they could be the agents through which the gospel would be spread. Eventually, He commissioned them, "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age." (Matthew 28:19-20, NRSV)

As you look around at the signs of Spring in the air, let me ask you a question? Are you making new friends? Are you seeking to connect with someone? The Holy Spirit often guides us in relationship so we can witness to one another and be a help to one another. Go then and make disciples. Go and share your faith! Happy Easter!

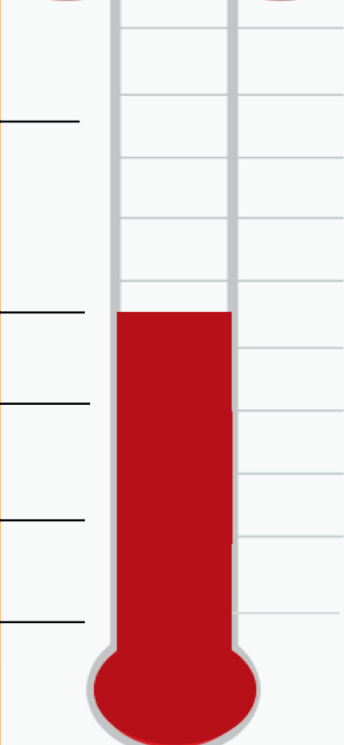
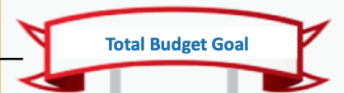

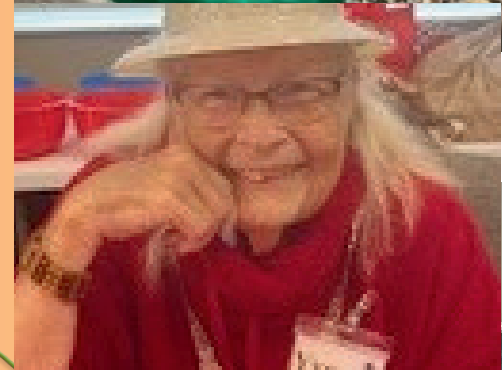

Sonrise Respite is three years old and celebrated its birthday on March 4 with balloons, party hats (decorated by the participants), music, games and birthday cupcakes (also decorated...and eaten...by the participants and volunteers)! Sonrise meets every Monday at LDUMC from 10 AM – 2 PM, and a hot lunch prepared by Chef Leo and his team is served each week. In the past three years we have served over 50 participants who are living with dementia, and we continue to maintain a waiting list of 16 people hoping to join Sonrise soon. We have a dedicated team of 43 volunteers who donate an estimate total of 3,828 volunteer hours per year. These volunteers have received special training and share their love and their talents with our Sonrise family each and every week. 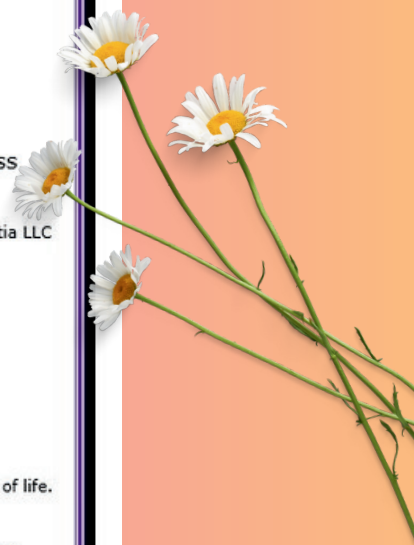
